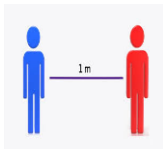


Wash your hands please

If you have ANY symptoms, or have been around anyone that has

Before coming out for your lesson please wash your hands for a
Minimum of 20 seconds using warm soapy water.

Please do not enter the car until I have wiped down all touch points
And controls in the car.

I will supply hand sanitiser to apply at beginning of the lesson or feel
Free to bring your own if you prefer.

If we have to swap seats during the lesson, all of the above will be
repeated.

To protect both of us, I will be implementing the use of face mask
During the lesson. These must be fitted to cover mouth and nose!
Lessons can not go ahead without. Please bring your own with you.
I do have a small supply but this will incur a £2 charge.

During the lesson, it maybe required to take regular breaks and
Get out of the car for a few moments. Providing the 1 metre
Guidelines are met we can take mask off for some fresh air. We
we can use this time to discuss progress and maybe learn the show
Me/tell me questions under the bonnet. Weather permitting.

Should anyone in our driving network, family members living in the same household or has been in contact with anyone with covid 19 symptoms (details of covid symptoms can be found on the NHS and Government websites) including myself, then please note that all lesson will be suspended until the current government guide lines with regard to self isolating have been met.
